

CONTEST RULES SUNSHINE COAST CREDIT UNION (SCCU)

June 13 Home and Garden Expo –Prize Draw “Contest”

1. How to Enter

To enter the Contest, submit an official ballot slip into the draw box the Home and Garden Expo at the Gibsons and Area Community Centre - 700 Park Drive on June 13,

- There is no entry fee and no purchase is necessary to enter this Contest.
- LIMIT one (1) entry per person.
- Contest closing date: In order to be eligible for the Contest, entries must be received by SCCU through an in-person ballot on June 13th 2015 between 10am and 4:00pm Vancouver BC Time.

2. Prize

There is one (1) Prize available to be won through a random draw consisting of:

One (1) patio set valued at approximately \$1000

In no case will SCCU be required to award more prizes than set forth herein, or award a prize other than as specified herein. No cash alternative to the prizes will be offered or provided by SCCU. The prizes are not transferable. Prizes are subject to availability and SCCU reserves the right to substitute any prize with another of equivalent value without giving notice.

3. Eligibility

This Contest is open to residents of British Columbia, nineteen (19) years old or over as of June 13 2015. SCCU employees, family living in the same household as an employee and directors are not eligible to win the Prizes.

4. Contact Date for Selected Entrants

SCCU will attempt to contact the winners (Selected Entrants) of the Contest by June 20 2015.

5. Selected Entrants Requirements

In order to win a prize, a Selected Entrant must:

- a) Sign a declaration form on behalf of himself or herself:
 - I. Confirming compliance with Contest Rules and acceptance of the Prize as offered;
 - II. Acknowledging the non-responsibility of SCCU, and its affiliated and related companies, and their respective officers, employees, directors, agent’s and retailer’s with respect to all damages, claims, injuries, accidents, loss or misfortune relating to the awarding, use and enjoyment of the Prize;

- b) Correctly answer a time-limited skill testing mathematical question.

If a Selected Entrant does not meet these requirements by this date, or cannot be contacted by SCCU after at least five (5) attempts during the two (2) week period after the draw, or is contacted but is unwilling or unable to comply in full with these Rules, the Selected Entrant will be disqualified and SCCU may, in its discretion, randomly select another entry in place of the disqualified entry.

6. Chance of Winning

The chance of being a winner is dependent upon the number of eligible entries received.

Personal information will be collected, used and disclosed by SCCU exclusively for the purposes of randomly drawing winners of the Contest as well as contacting entrants if they requested follow up by indicating so on their Ballot Slip, in accordance with SCCU’s Privacy Policy, as is posted on SCCU’s website.

8. Contest Laws and Regulations

The contest is subject to all applicable Federal, Provincial, Municipal, and local laws and regulations. The Prize is non-transferable, has no cash value and must be accepted as awarded with no substitution except at the sole and absolute discretion of SCCU. SCCU is not responsible for lost or incomplete entries. SCCU reserves the right to discontinue the Contest or alter the Contest Rules at any time should reasons beyond its control make the Contest unable to be administered as planned.

9. Disqualification

SCCU reserves the right to review all entries and to disqualify from participation any individual whose entry does not comply with the requirements set out in these Rules.
